ARTICLE 1


Shall general obligation bonds or notes or other evidences of indebtedness of the Town of Fair Haven in an amount not to exceed One Million Four Hundred Seventy-Five Thousand Dollars (\$1,475,000), such indebtedness subject to reduction from the receipt of available state and federal grants-in-aid, be issued for the purpose of financing the cost of acquisition and construction of a public works garage, including a salt shed, the estimated cost of such improvements being One Million Four Hundred Seventy-Five Thousand Dollars (\$1,475,000)?




